Anchor: He passed a polygraph test. That is the word of an attorney for a Fresno man suspected by relatives of killing his wife.

The attorney for Mark Adanalian says his client was asked key questions about the life and death of his wife. One year ago, 37-year-old Linda Adanalian mysteriously collapsed near Selland Arena after taking her kids to see an ice skating show. Since then her relatives have paid for tests that allegedly show high concentrations of selenium in her body. And they have suggested her husband Mark may have poisoned her. But his attorney now says, Mark volunteered and passed a polygraph test.

Reporter: Was one of the questions, “did you kill your wife?”

Warren: Umm I’m not certain, but the relevant question would have been, did she ingest selenium. He’s also gone on the record your news organization, and number of news organizations saying he didn’t kill his wife.”

Anchor: Both sides of the family are waiting on the Fresno County Coroner to render a judgment on the exact cause of death.
